Cultural and heritage trips as part of a chaperoned group.

Expected outcomes and impact: This course offers a professional development opportunity for participants which aims to provide teachers with innovative and creative solutions for teaching Secondary learners.

CULTURAL PROGRAMME

The courses are delivered in Atlantic Language School in Galway on Ireland's 'Wild Atlantic' Coast, and participants will have ample opportunity to learn about the cultural heritage of both Ireland and the local area.
